# Fairfield County USBC Association Women's Tournament

- 1.) The Tournament shall be governed by USBC rules and regulations except as hereinafter set forth.
- 2.) **ELIGIBILITY**: Any female bowler who is currently sanctioned with USBC and is a member of the Fairfield County USBC Association (FCUSBC) may participate in this Tournament. To be eligible to participate, the bowler must be a member of FCUSBC *at least fifteen* (15) days prior to competing in the Tournament. **USBC Youth Sanctioned Bowlers are not permitted to bowl**.
  - a. Any bowler holding a current membership in the Professional Bowlers Association (PBA) must indicate so at time of entry.
- 3.) **FORMAT**: The Tournament format is as follows:
  - I. <u>Team</u> Teams shall consist of four (4) bowlers (women only).
    - a. No more than two (2) members of the PBA may compete on a team.
    - b. Bowlers may enter and re-enter the Team event as many times as possible. Re-entry of same team based upon availability. A bowler's first competition in the Team event will be used towards All-Events.
    - c. If teams comprised of more than three (3) of the same bowler's place in the final standings, only the team with the highest placement shall be awarded prizes. All teams shall bowl three (3) games on their assigned pair of lanes.
  - II. <u>Singles and Doubles</u> Teams shall consist of two (2) bowlers (*women only*).
    - a. No more than one (1) member of the PBA may compete on a team.
    - b. Any bowler wishing to bowl either the Singles or Doubles event must enter to bowl both events.
    - c. Bowlers may re-enter the Doubles event and as the previous rule states, singles would also have to be bowled.
      - a. If bowling with the same partner only the highest score will cash.
      - b. Bowlers bowling singles twice will be allowed to only cash once.
    - d. All teams shall bowl six (6) games on the same pair, three (3) for Doubles and (3) for Singles.
    - e. The Doubles event shall be bowled first.
  - III. <u>Senior</u> Teams shall consist of one (1) bowler of at least the age of fifty (50).
    - a. Bowlers may only enter the Senior event once.
    - b. All bowlers will use their *first* three (3) games bowled in the Tournament competition for standings.
    - c. The Senior event shall be divided into the following classifications (AGE CLASSIFICATION AS OF JULY 1, 2025):
      - 1. <u>Super Senior</u> Age 75 and older
- 2. <u>Division 'A'</u> Age 70 to 74
- Division 'B' Age 65 to 69

- 4. <u>Division 'C'</u> Age 60 to 64
- 5. Division 'D' Age 55 to 59 6. Division 'E' Age 50 to 54
- IV. <u>All-Events</u> Shall be calculated using all nine (9) games bowled (Team, Singles, & Doubles). **If bowling multiple times in any one event the FIRST SERIES BOWLED WILL BE USED. <u>PAID ENTRY FEE FOR ALL-EVENTS MUST BE MADE PRIOR TO BOWLING 1<sup>ST</sup> EVENT.</u>**
- 4.) This shall be a **Handicap** based tournament. Handicap shall be calculated based upon 100% of the difference between a bowler's USBC average and 245. Maximum handicap is 95 pins per game based upon a 150 average.
- 5.) **AVERAGES**: Averages used for calculating handicap shall be determined as follows:
  - a. Highest USBC sanctioned average from any association from the 2023-2024 Winter Season (min. 21 games)
  - b. If no average from (a), highest USBC sanctioned average from any association from the 2024 Summer Season (min. 21 games)
  - c. If no average from (a) or (b) then the highest current USBC sanctioned average as of November 16, 2024 (min. 21 games)
  - d. If no verifiable average from (a), (b), or (c), bowler shall bowl SCRATCH
  - e. If a bowler has a Standard average and a Sport or Challenge average, the highest average without conversion will be issued
    - i. If a bowler has only a Sport or Challenge average, the current conversion chart per the USBC rule book will be used to adjust the average to a Standard average
  - f. Upon request of the Tournament Manager, averages must be certified by the local Association Manager or League Secretary
  - g. The 10-pin rule will not be in effect. Tournament management reserves the right to adjust any bowler's average as deemed necessary and bowlers should familiarize themselves with Rule 319 for Average Submissions and Average Adjustments
- 6.) **ENTRY FEE**: The entry fee per event shall be as follows:
  - a. Team, Doubles, and Singles shall be fifty (\$50) dollars per person per event.
  - b. All-Events shall be five (\$5) dollars per person per event.
  - c. Senior event shall be ten (\$10) dollars per eligible bowler.
  - ${\tt d.} \quad \text{No refund of entry fee will be made after the entry has been processed and squad time} (s) \ have been assigned.$
- 7.) **PRIZES**: Prizes shall be awarded as follows:
  - a. Team, Doubles, and Singles event prizes shall be returned 100% at the **ratio of 1 in 8** with 30% awarded to 'Scratch' prizes.
  - b. All-Events prizes shall be returned 100% at the **ratio of 1 in 8**.
  - c. Senior event prizes shall be returned 50% per division at the **ratio of 1 in 8**.
  - d. If in any event a bowler or bowlers qualify for both Handicap and Scratch prizes, only the greater prize shall be awarded. If the Handicap and Scratch payouts are identical THE HANDICAP PAYOUT WILL BE USED.
- 8.) **CHECK-IN**: Team captains must check-in with Tournament Officials at least thirty (30) minutes prior to squad time.
  - a. Substitutions must be submitted to Tournament Officials at the time of check-in.
- 9.) PACERS: USBC Rule 323 is waived; Pacers will not be permitted.
- 10.) **SPECIAL AWARDS**: Special awards shall be as follows:
  - a. <u>Handicap and Scratch Team</u> champions of the Annual Association Tournament shall have their entry fees paid for by FCUSBC to represent the FCUSBC at the Annual Connecticut State Bowling Association Tournament.
  - b. All Champions, including Senior event, shall receive one (1) paid invitation to the annual FCUSBC Awards Dinner.
  - c. FCUSBC shall present Champions with an appropriate award in recognition of their achievement.
  - d. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to amend the Special Awards as they see fit.
- 11.) The Tournament Manager shall have the authority to decide upon matters not covered by the aforementioned rules.
- 12.) Prize money and final standings shall be distributed within thirty (30) days after the completion of competition.
